Project Description

The project will provide funding and support for 3 high schools to participate in the Financial Literacy high school pilot. Participating schools will conduct a basic self-assessment of existing financial literacy practices and identify resources/strategies to strengthen their approach.

** Final school selection will be completed in September and a detailed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) provided for the school pending grant award.*

- October 30: Self-assessment complete and key strategies identified
- November 30: Grant award processed
- Fall 2018 – 2020: Project implementation

Program Expectations

The Education Alliance* will provide: (**in collaboration with partners*)

- Guidance for completing self-assessment of current financial literacy practices
- Professional development and networking opportunities for participating schools
- Grant funding to each school to implement the project
- Communication and coordination among participating partners
- Evaluation report to measure program impact

The School will:

- Receive \$2,000 grant and training to strengthen schools' approach to Financial Literacy
- Participate in professional development and technical assistance regarding Financial Literacy
- Identify key resources and strategies to implement
- Participate in data collection to measure project impact
